Notes: In the 1860s, Corot was still mixing peasant figures with mythological ones, mixing Neoclassicism

with Realism. Late in life his human figures did increase and the nymphs did decrease, but even the

human figures were often set in idyllic reveries.

Corot's studio was filled with students, models, friends, collectors, and dealers Dealers snapped up his works and his prices were often above 4,000 francs per painting. Throughout his life he was a

humble, modest man, who remained apolitical and happy with his luck in life.

He died in Paris at age 78 and was buried at Père Lachaise Cemetery.
